Some of my accomplishments at AACE

- Founded the Central PA section in 1990
- Founded the Idaho Snake River section in 1996
- Current chair of the Ed Board (past 3-4 years) and have served the Ed Board for 12 years,
- Was lead writer and editor of the 1st edition of the PSP Certification Study Guide
- Co-authored the Planning RP with Ted Douglas
- I received the OT Zimmerman Award back in 2006,
- Outstanding SIG Chair (Academic SIG) in 2010,
- Was voted a Fellow in June 2013 and will receive my Fellow Award in New Orleans.
- I also served on the Governance Task back in 2011-12 that changed the make-up of the board of directors that will take effect in June
- The last two annual meetings I have taught 3 tracks of the skills and knowledge track and I'm working on teaching two more tracks in New Orleans.
- This past November I had the opportunity to go to Russia and support the Greater Russian Section in teaching a two day course on Planning and Scheduling and may be going back in May to teach Skills and Knowledge
